

# Agent Instructions - Buying Buddy Migration Prompt

**Who this is for:** Clients who built their site with **HighLevel Ai Studio** and originally installed Buying Buddy the old way — the JavaScript plugin `<script>` plus HTML `<bb-widget>` elements. This prompt converts your site to the new Buying Buddy plugin designed for Ai Studio.

**This is a one-time migration.** New Ai Studio sites should use the AI setup prompt in the Buying Buddy dashboard instead.

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## How this works (read before you begin)

This migration involves a few changes in your Buying Buddy account **and** the AI prompt below. Some of the account settings need values that the AI works out for you, so the order matters. Here is the full sequence:

### Step A - Set your Website Type (do this now).

Login to your Buying Buddy dashboard then go to: **Widgets > Website Options** (<https://www.leadsandcontacts.com/site/domain-settings>).

The **Website Settings** tab should be selected on the left.

In the banner at the top of the panel, click **Change Website Type** and set it to **HighLevel Ai Studio**.

The page will refresh and show the new type.

Leave this dashboard tab open — you will come back to it in Step C.

### Step B - Run the AI prompt.

Paste the prompt from the PDF "[Instructions\\_FOR\\_AI\\_assistant\\_Migration\\_Prompt.pdf](#)" into your AI Studio assistant.

Its first action is to give you two things: your **Preview domain** — only needed if you want to preview the migrated site before publishing — and, if your site has a sticky header, three **Widget Header Offset** numbers.

The prompt will then pause and wait for you to complete Step C:

### Step C - Enter those values in your Buying Buddy account.

Back on the **Widgets > Website Options** page (Website Settings tab):

1. **Add your Preview domain** (*optional* — *only if you want to preview the migrated site before publishing*): scroll down to the **Vibe Preview Domain** section. Paste the Vibe Preview domain the AI gave you into the input field and click the blue **Add Vibe Preview Domain** button on the right. Skip it only if you intend to publish straight away and verify on the live site.
2. **Enter the Widget Header Offset** (only if the AI said your site has a sticky/fixed header): in the **Widget Header Offset** panel — just below the Domain Name and SSL panel — enter the three numbers the AI gave you into **Mobile**, **Tablet**, and **Desktop**, then save. (This stops map widgets from being hidden under your header. It can also be done later.)

### Step D — Tell the AI to continue.

Go back to the AI and confirm you have set the Website Type and added the Vibe Preview domain. The AI will then proceed with the migration.

### Domain Name and SSL

**Domain Name**  
**Important** - Your domain name should match the domain name shown in the browser address bar. For example, if you use 'www' then this should also show the 'www'. If this is incorrect, then navigation within widgets may fail. For any changes to domain name, submit a help ticket.

Add that preview URL here so your search widgets and MLS data also work while you're building — before you publish to your live domain. You can have one preview domain per website.

### Widget Header Offset

If your website has a fixed or sticky header, you can set a header offset for each screen size. This prevents the sticky Results and Map widgets from being hidden behind your site header.  
• Set the height of your website's fixed header so sticky widgets are positioned below it.  
• Leave empty if not needed.
